MRT Information

If you would like to explore and to experience the true face of Taipei by yourself, the most economical and logical way for you is to use the Metro Rapid Transit System (MRT). The Taipei MRT system is well indicated with English signs. Tickets can be purchased from the tickets machines or tickets office in the MRT stations. The fare is based on the trip distance and starts at NT\$20. For frequent uses, a one-day ticket is also available at the MRT stations for NT\$150 with unlimited travel times. The MRT station nearest to the Congress Venue is the *Taipei City Hall Station* on the Blue Line. An easy card, which can only be used in Taiwan with amount NT\$50 will be included in the congress package for you to explore many interesting places in Taipei. Cash is accepted at most stations and you can add value to your Easy Card using either cash or bank/credit cards. The easy card is **recyclable** and if you don't want to keep it as a souvenir – please return the card to the Congress Information Desk. By so doing, we could have another better use of it for any other time.

Note: Food and drinks are not allowed in the MRT system, plain water exclusive. Passengers who eat or drink in the MRT system are liable to a fine of up to NT\$7,500.

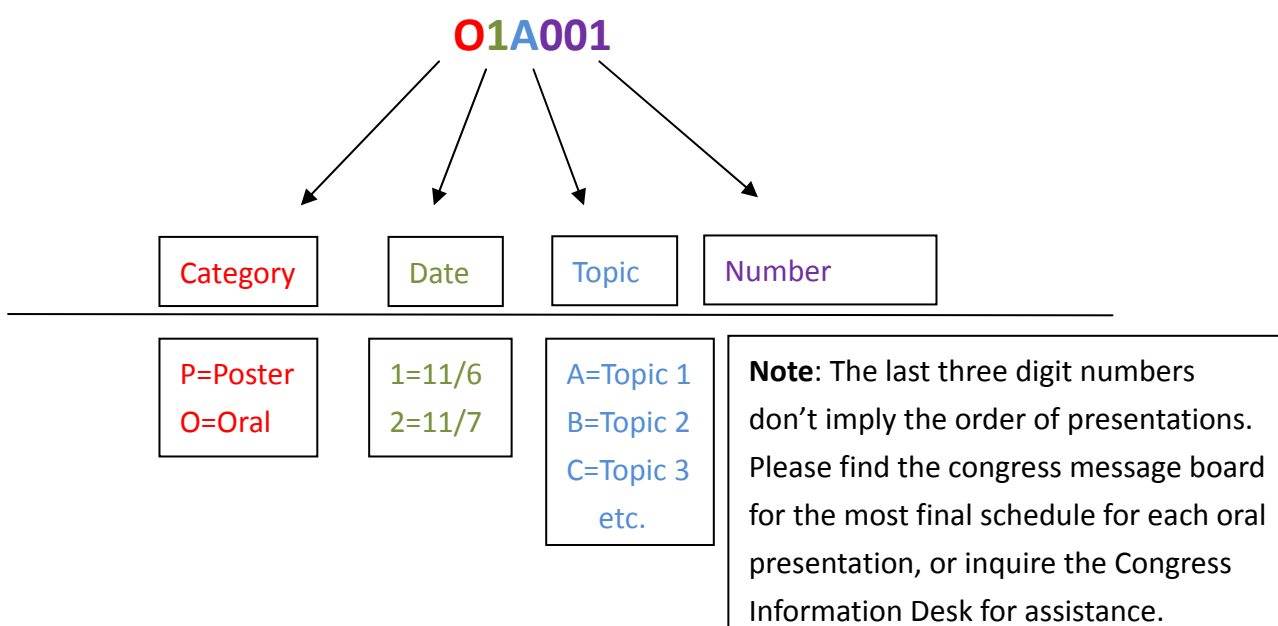

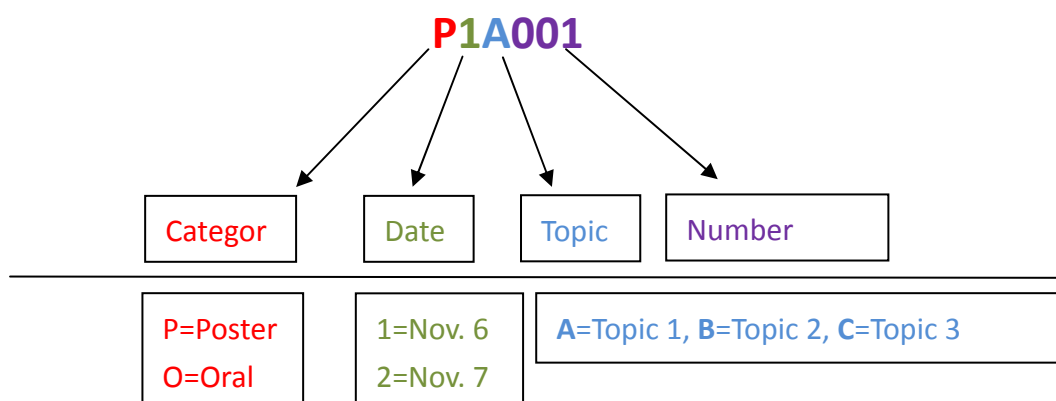

Lunch will be provided at 3F, Banquet Hall, Taipei International Convention Center (TICC). Your name badge will be verified.

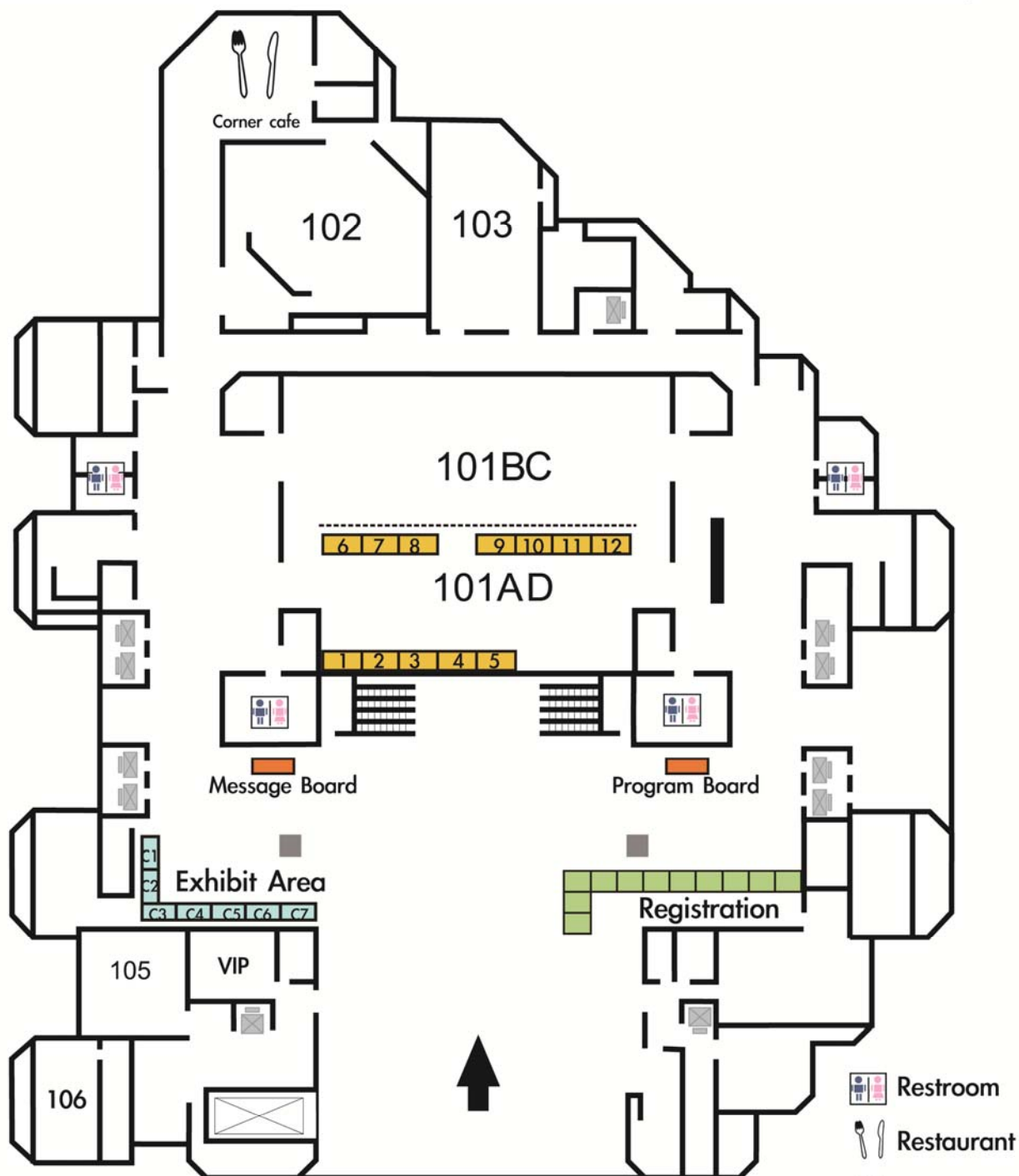
Access to Internet

- Please note that mobile phone must be switched off or switched into vibration mode during all sessions.

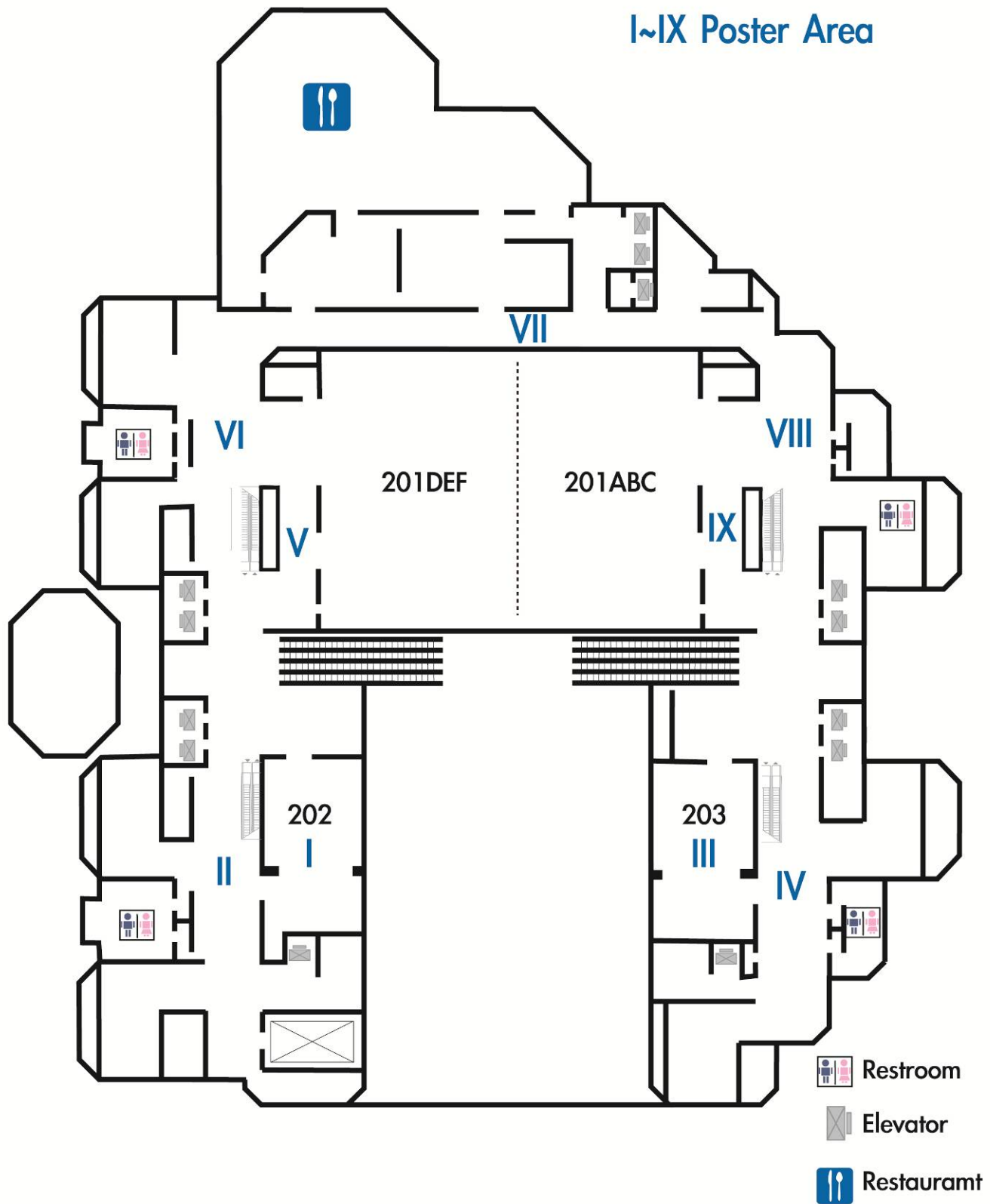
TICC 1F Floor Plan
